



COVID19 PARENT UPDATE: Onsite Guidelines for Families & Students

Tuesday 4th August, 2020

Dear Parents, Carers and 502 community

To assist with a smooth transition back into Emergency Remote Learning, we have developed these 'Onsite Guidelines' to assist our families and students who will be attending school onsite.

If your child has been granted access to our onsite learning, following your application to the principal, we would like you to read through these Guidelines:

Drop off/Pick up Information

- Students must enter school through the front door of the main building (office). This will be the only building open at school. Parents/carers are to remain outside the school grounds at all times.
- Arrive no earlier than 8.30am, unless your child arrives by bus
- Students to use sanitiser when they enter the office
- Students will be temperature checked on arrival. If they have a temperature of equal to or above 37.5 degrees, they will be sent home
- Parents/carers are not to enter the school grounds at all. Please contact the office on 5358 1255 if you need to contact a staff member
- Optional: You may wish to send your child in with their own soap, sanitiser and tissues (we will provide them at school too)
- Pick up time: Students must be collected from the front gate. Parents are to wait out the front, making sure they are maintaining the correct social distancing. Parents are asked to take students straight home, there is not to be any playtime or hanging around together at all. School finishes at 3.20pm and we ask for quick pick up. We will no longer be using staggered pick-up times during Remote Learning. If you require further After School Care beyond 3.20pm, please contact Aussie Kindies (5358 4266) and let us know if your child will be collected by Aussie Kindies from school via XUNO.
- If you need to cancel your booking, please send message via XUNO as usual to let us know by 9.00am.
- All children who are unwell MUST stay home
- Any child who becomes unwell at school will be sent home.

What does my child need to bring?

- Students **are not** required to wear school uniform, although they must wear enclosed footwear
- If your child usually walks to and from school, they can continue to do so but you need to let us know via XUNO
- Students need to bring their own drink bottle (bubble taps will not be used), packed lunch and snacks (canteen will not be available at all during Term 3 Remote Learning)
- Bring a coat if weather is cool
- Students may bring their own tablet (eg. Ipad) from home to use when not completing set tasks (at own risk). Mobile phones/Smart Watches are not permitted

- Students must bring their fully charged laptop/charger/headphones to school for each day that they are attending and take it home each night to be charged

What does Onsite Remote Learning look like?

- Students will be working in classrooms within the main building (all other buildings will be closed) in P-2, 3-4 and 5-6 groups (when possible)
- Students will not always be supervised at school by their own teacher. We will be using a roster system for teachers supervising at school while most teachers will be working from their homes
- Playground equipment will be out-of-bounds in Term 3 Remote Learning
- Students will be supervised to do their 'Remote Learning' activities, as set by their classroom teacher. They will be working on the same learning as students who are at home learning. This work will be a greatly reduced 'emergency' program, and will not resemble a 'normal' school day in many ways
- Supervising staff will try to ensure that onsite schooling is a safe and happy place for students.
