Attendance


This year we are focusing on attendance. It is important that we monitor attendance, and for parents and families to contact the Office when their child is away.

Every student in our school has a great day, every day.






Students lead DASH project up and running.




PARKING REMINDER



The Stawell Amateur Athletic Club (SAAC) Cross Country running season commences on Saturday 18th March 2023.

Sub-junior races are a variety of 1 kilometre course and for young runners starting out in the sport

from 4 years old to roughly 10 years old. Junior category is for young runners who can confidently run 3 km-4 km cross country events.

Senior events range from 3 km to 16 km.

All races are handicapped giving all runners an equal chance of winning.

Meet at the Stawell Amateur Athletic Club Clubhouse, North Park, for registration from 9am aiming to start Sub-juniors and Juniors at 9.30am. There will be a morning tea follow the first race at the clubhouse located near the North Park athletics track.

Membership for the 2023 season is \$35 for adults, \$20 for juniors, \$15 for sub juniors and \$50 for

families. Membership entitles runners to participate in all 18 club runs for the 2023 season.


