Request for Parents to Support the School in Banning Snapchat:







Easter Hat Parade














ANZAC Ceremony








PARKING REMINDER

Read and Re-hide fun




Students participated in the fun of reading a re-hiding books at Cato Lake. A Lock-down idea that has evolved and is encouraging children of all ages to read.
